The Citizens Police Academy is intended to be an overview of the Auburn & Lewiston Police Departments' functions and operations. Participants will **not** be trained as police officers. Class size is limited and will be filled on a first-come basis. Participants must attend at least ten classes to pass the Citizens Police Academy. **A background check will be performed on ALL applicants. Applicants with felony convictions or extensive criminal backgrounds will not be accepted.** Application deadline is March 5, 2010.
