Then on Sunday Oct. 14, we had the Dempsey Challenge and there were 28 volunteers that work the SAG and Rest Stops. The day started with rain and cold, the rain stop but the cold didn't. But all ended well and early, the last trekkers finished at 5pm.

We also move the portable tower to the Goff Hill Repeater site, and placed the 440 Antenna on the tower. Now, we are working on the 440 Radio to fine tune the squelch.

Secretary's Report

The Androscoggin Amateur Radio Club held a meeting Wednesday October 3, 2012 at the LaPage Conference Center in Lewiston, Maine. In attendance: n1oxe, n1oxa, w1scm and son Charles, w1ltx, kb1qhr, w1lwt, kb1doi, wa1skp, n1nyw, k1wtx, n1dot and w1sab.

The meeting was called to order by the Treasurer Ivan n1oxa at 7:03 PM because the President and Vice President were absent. Andy kb1doi made a motion to approve the Secretarys' report as printed in the Acorn. The Motion was seconded by Bob w1ltx. Vote: approved.

Ivan read the Treasurers' report and noted that the major expenses were insurance and the Post Office box rent. Bob w1ltx made a motion to approve the report, that motion was seconded by Dave n1oxe.

In old business, the Auburn Middle School confirmed they are interested in the ham radio contact with the space station and have 300 students who would like to have some club members go to the school and teach them about ham radio before the space station contact. We will work on that. Ivan detailed some of the things NASA requires for the event, a seventy five watt transmitter with a preamp, and automatic tracking antennas to name a few. Arrangements are being made to have the IBEW supply and operate a lift to place the antennas on the roof and the use of the Androscoggin County Comm Truck are just some of the plans in the works. Ivan reports that a student ham will be making the contact and Bates has told NASA that the time between 11 a.m. and 2 p.m. will fit their class schedule. There is still no word on exactly what date and time the contact will be.

Ivan also told us that the SET is October 6 and that no one will have to go far if anywhere to participate. A major fire will be the subject of the event.

Also Ivan reports the hospital drill was postponed last month and will be held October 13 at 7:45 a.m. before the Oxford County Mass Casualty drill. On October 14 the Dempsey Challenge will be held with Club members in SAG vehicles and others at rest stops. Ivan explained more about the event.

Also there was work done last week getting the crank up tower in place on Goff Hill and Ivan explained that the antenna connection was corroded and was cleaned up as best they could and got a good swr match. (Pictures on the w1npp.org web site) The Motorola tech will stop by the next time he is called to the hill for work on commercial equipment and will check out the clubs 2 meter and 440 repeaters to see if they need any repairs or adjustment. Three volunteers were enlisted to help get the crank up tower placed in its permanent location.

There will be no talk this fall about SETI because the speaker will be down under in Australia watching an eclipse. Maybe next year?

Shawn w1sab would like to have us talk at next months meeting about ways to increase attendance at the next hamfest / ARRL Convention. It was suggested that a more valuable prize might bring in more people. Please bring your ideas to the November meeting. Also if you would like to help coordinate the event please attend.

Bob w1ltx made a motion to adjourn that was seconded by David n1oxe. Vote Approved. Meeting ended at 8:09 p.m.
